Scholarship Opportunities for Sophomores and Juniors!

Upshur Rural Electric Cooperative along with eight other cooperatives in the northeast Texas area are making plans for the 29th annual East Texas Rural Electric Youth Seminar (*ETREYS*). *ETREYS* is an all-expense paid week-long leadership and motivational seminar that was developed to promote Cooperative philosophy, ideals and values among young people. Speakers will include nationally-known personalities, college professors and community leaders. Students will be given the opportunity to enhance their leadership and problem-solving skills in a positive learning environment on a college campus as well as compete for scholarship monies that will be awarded during the week.

URECC will sponsor 15 students for the seminar which will be held at East Texas Baptist University in Marshall, Texas the week of June 26—June 30, 2017. Students in their sophomore or junior year in high school who are interested in a “life-changing experience” by taking part in the seminar have until April 17, 2017 to submit an application. Right-Of-Way Program

Upshur Rural Electric Cooperative has no control over power outages caused by severe weather; *however*, the frequency and duration of outages can be limited through a vigilant right-of-way clearing program.

Tree trimming, and all phases of right-of-

-way maintenance, are essential to ensuring reliable electric service. This is particularly true in rural areas where trees and other vegetation are more dense. A major portion of electric interruptions are caused by momentary contact between power

lines and tree limbs. Supplying safe and reliable electric service is a top priority, and our right-of-way maintenance program is vital in helping us meet that commitment to our Members. If you are planning to plant any trees, locate the power lines before

any digging. Plant trees far enough away so they will not come in contact with the lines.
